Dear Councillor Kitterick,

I have looked into this matter for you and can positively confirm that there are currently no plans to build a new bridge over the River Soar in this part of Leicester with the associated highway improvements required to create the link to Evesham Road. This would be significant project requiring substantial funding to be secured and a lot of planning.

In addition, there is currently no identified need for a future strategic link at this location following the highway improvements and bridge works that were carried out along Upperton Rd a few years ago.

However, the option to develop the link has been retained by the Council to ensure flexibility in a strategic planning context, particularly when considering long term options for the development of the City's transport network, including rapid transport systems, bus routes, cycleways and pedestrian routes. Any firm proposals would have to go through statutory consultation and planning processes.

That said, it is very unlikely that any such options will be considered and developed in the near future, i.e. within the next ten to fifteen years.

There may be development proposals for the Faircharm Industrial Estate and this may require us to consider how we improve the highway access to the estate. Again, any proposals would have to go through the formal planning process.
