### **You asked for:**

**a traffic light sequence report of the junction at Melton Road and Troon Way, for an accident occurring 23rd 1st 2012, at 19:40.

### **ANSWER**

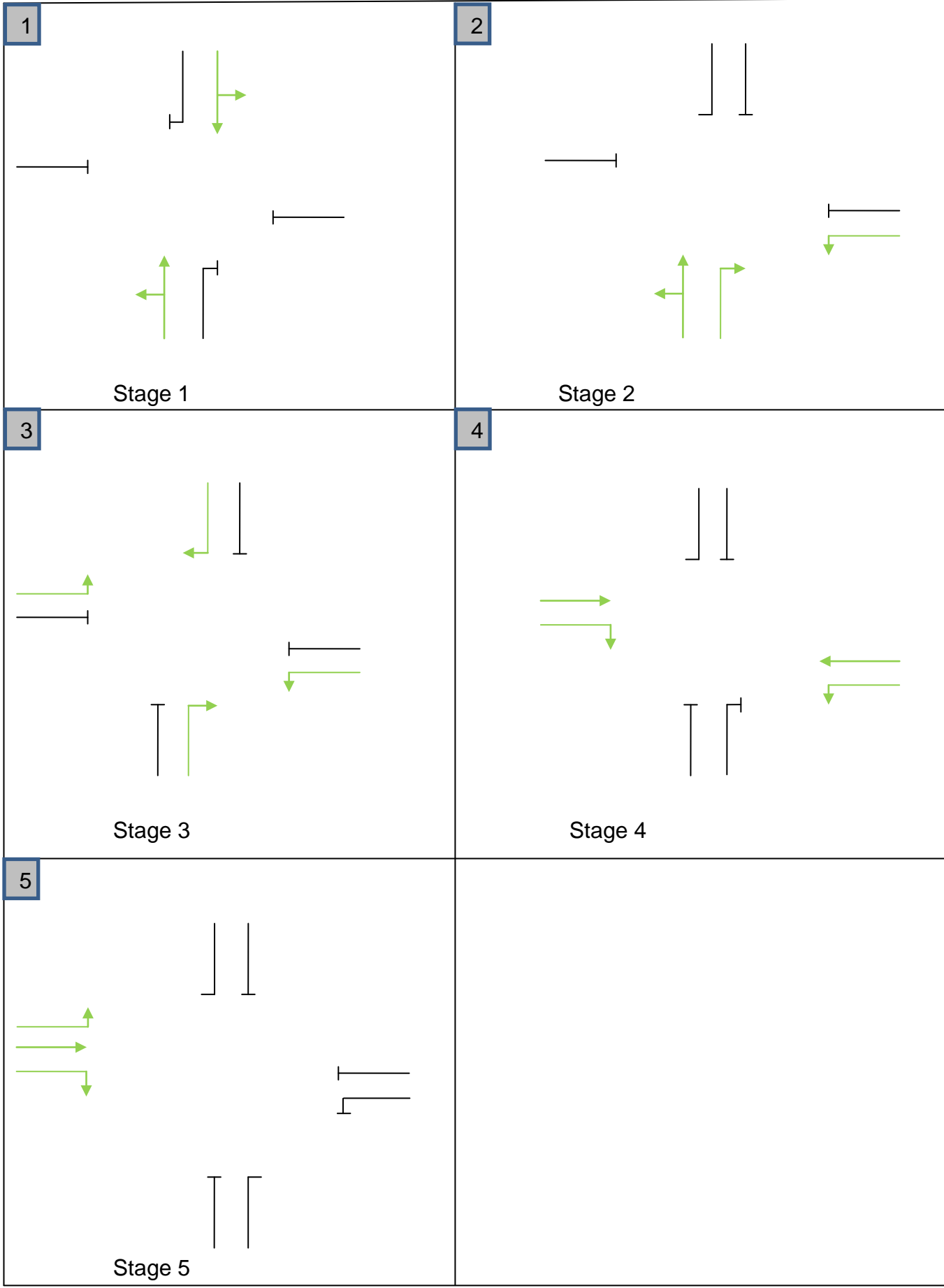
RTA: Melton Rd/Troon Way, Leicester.

Date: 23rd January 2012

The staging sequence for the junction is as follows:

- Stage 1: A607 Melton Road northbound, ahead and left turn and A607 Melton Road Southbound ahead and left. All other movements shown a red signal.
- Stage 2: A607 Melton Road southbound ahead and left turn. A607 Melton Road Southbound right turn and A563 Watermead Way left turn. All other movements shown a red signal.
- Stage 3: A607 Melton Road southbound right turn and A607 Melton Road northbound right turn. Vehicles are able to filter left from Watermead Way into A607 Melton Rd northbound. All other movements shown a red signal.
- Stage 4: A563 Watermead Way and Troon Way. Traffic is able to turn right from Troon Way into A607 Melton Rd northbound through gaps in the opposing traffic. All other movements shown a red signal.
- Stage 5: A563 Troon Way ahead, left and right turn. The right turning traffic is able to carry out the manoeuvre, avoiding any conflicts with the opposing traffic from A563 Watermead Way. All other movements shown a red signal.
