Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

RE: Victoria Jubilee, 112 Leire Street, Leicester

I should be grateful if you would kindly confirm whether any enforcement action (noise/public nuisance) has been taken against either of the premises over the last 2 years; and also if there are any particular issues at the present time.

I look forward to hearing from you.

ANSWER

We can confirm that there has been no enforcement action taken by the Licensing Section in relation to Victoria Jubilee, 112 Leire Street.

Also the Noise Team have not taken any enforcement action for noise from this premises in the last 2 years. There are no particular noise issues at this time.

Although you ask regarding action against 'either of the premises' but you only give the address of one. Feel free to put in another request, detailing the other address you are referring to.
