Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

**You asked:**

**RE: Greater Leicester Bus Map – For Sept 2012, Oct 2012 and Jan 2013 editions, please supply:**

- A) the number printed**
- B) the cost of each edition**
- C) the list of outlets that they were sent to**
- D) the number sent to each outlet,**

**ANSWER**

The distribution of the bus map is as follows.

### **Sept 2012**

No Printed = 5,000

Cost = £1,640

Outlets & No to each Outlet = These were bulk distributed to the main operators, Arriva, First and Centrebus. They were also given to the Central Lending Library, De Montfort University, University of Leicester, Tourist Information Centre and the Customer Services Centre. Individual guides were sent out to those who requested them using the online form.

### **Oct 2012**

No Printed = 3,000

Cost = £964 (minor revisions & printing)

Outlets & No to each Outlet = This is as Sept 2012.

The Oct 2012 map needed printing as there were further changes to Humberstone Gate East that needed to be incorporated onto the Guide.

### **Jan 2013**

No Printed = 5,000

Cost = £2,574 (revisions & printing – this was slightly more as printing was done in 2 batches, 3,000 and 2,000)

Outlets & No to each Outlet = as attached

There have been numerous editions in a short space of time due to the Humberstone Gate East works.
