Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Under the general requirements of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would be grateful if you would provide the following information in relation to Robinson Road, Leicester, in particular the section joining Robison Road to Coleman Road.

I would much obliged if you can provide me answers to the below questions regarding the Robinson Road, Leicester.

ANSWER:

The information that we are supplying is detailed below and the relevant documents are attached to this letter.

- **1. Dates of all safety inspections undertaken on the carriageway in the past two years**

Document showing details of routine safety inspections carried out on Robinson Road since March 2011.

- **2. Details of all road defects identified during safety inspections in the past two years**

Copies of work orders issued showing all carriageway defects identified on Robinson Road during safety inspections from March 2011, reference numbers: 10115920, 11122850 & 12133670.

- **3. Details of how road safety inspections are undertaken.**

Safety inspections of Robinson Road are walked.

- **4. The frequency of road safety inspections.**

Robinson Road is inspected two times per year.

- **5. The road/section number.**

The road section number for Robinson Road is 23102530_A.
