You asked:

Copies of the original correspondence that Cllr Sood received from Cllr Clarke regarding the two bids listed above to the Aylestone Ward Fund from the Gilmorton Development Group.

ANSWER:

Please see attached emails as requested. Some junior staff names have been removed as we consider that to be an absolute exemption under section 40(2) (personal data), and this therefore constitutes a refusal under section 17 of the Freedom of information Act 2000.

Confirmation of the dates of all meetings that took place after the 21 January 2013 regarding the two bids to the Aylestone Ward Fund from the Gilmorton Development Group.

2 Executive Member sign-off meetings were held after the 21st January. The dates for these were 31st January 2013 and the 7th February 2013. These are the only meetings that took place where the Gilmorton development was discussed.
