

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

-Total primary school (first school admissions) requests for admissions in Leicestershire including Leicester City and the total number who got places for 2013-2014 admission year

There were 4,148 on time applications for children living in Leicester and 4,148 children were allocated school places. Of these, 3,896 places are in Leicester City and 252 places are outside Leicester city – mainly in Leicestershire County Council.

-The school class sizes at Eyres Monsell primary school for the past 5 years, including reception, class 1 and class 2.

-The number of teachers (not including assistant teachers) for reception class, class 1 and class 2 for the year 2013-2014 in Eyres Monsell primary School.

-The intake number for Eyres Monsell primary 2013-2014 and the places offered according to the over subscriptions criteria.

The Published Admission Number for 2013 to 2014 is 30 places. None of the places allocated were allocated through the oversubscriptions criteria as the number of on time applications was fewer than the Published Admission. Hence the oversubscriptions criteria did not have to be used.

-The class size numbers for Glen Hills primary school. Including reception, class 1 and class 2 for the past 5 years.

-The Class sizes required by the LA for the past 5 years at Glen Hills Primary school.

-The amount of appeals at Glen Hills primary school in the past 5 school intakes, including each years data, the amount of appeals and the amount of places won via appeal.

-The number of teachers (not including assistant teachers) for reception class, class 1 and class 2 for the year 2013-2014 at Glen Hills primary school.

-The number of teachers (not including assistant teachers) for reception class, class 1 and class 2 for the year 2013-2014 at Fairfield community primary.

-The primary school performance results in Leicester in performance order, including Eyres Monsell Primary school, Glen Hills Primary School and Fairfield Community Primary School, against the national average.
