Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

I seek the following information:

- 1. The number of car parking facilities which are administered or owned by your local authority setting out total capacity of these facilities for cars and motorcycles.**

ANSWER

The following list includes Off Street and Multi storey car parks in the city where a charge is payable. Capacity indicated is for both cars and motorcycles.

Haymarket Centre - 485
Newarke Street (Phoenix Car Park) – 470
The Lanes – 55
Dover Street – 164
Granville road – 70
Victoria Park – 120
St Margarets Pastures – 125
Abbey Park – 80

Please also see attached '3200 Attachment1' which is a list from our Property Information system where assets are recorded as "carpark" for all assets held by the Authority. These only give gross area details for the car parks not how they are divided into spaces!

Also '3200 Attachment2' which details the sites managed by Jon Williams providing the number of car and motorbike spaces.

- 2. The number of facilities for commercial and heavy goods vehicle parking which are administered or owned by your local authority, detailing the total capacity of these facilities for commercial and heavy goods.**
- 3. The number of facilities which allow commercial and heavy goods vehicles to be parked between 18:00 – 8:00 in spaces designated for cars and motorcycle between 8:00 – 18:00 and how many will be converted for dual use over the next three years.**

Our Property division do not provide any HGV spaces or at present have any plans to convert existing spaces.
