

## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

**You asked:**

**I am seeking the following information in electronic form - preferably as a spreadsheet.**

**I am trying to get a picture of the composition of state funded nurseries in England. As such, I would like to know which nurseries in your local authority have received funding as part of the Government's scheme of providing free early education for 2, 3 and 4 year olds (as set out at <https://www.gov.uk/free-early-education>). I am interested in any nurseries that have received such funding since 1 September 2010.**

**For each nursery I would therefore like to know:**

- **Its name**
- **Its postcode**
- **Its religious character/ethos/designation, if this is known**
- **Whether free places were provided in the 2010-11 academic year (and if possible, how many)**
- **Whether free places were provided in the 2011-12 academic year (and if possible, how many)**
- **Whether free places were provided in the 2012-13 academic year (and if possible, how many)**
