**Records of Environmental Concerns such as drainage of industrial waste**

The Council does not hold information relating to drainage of industrial waste. This information request would need directing to the Environment Agency and / or Severn Trent Water.

**Is the site decommissioned safely from retail of petrol**

The site was decommissioned by foam filling of the tank farm by RGF (company) in mid 2011.

The tanks are still in situ, but are filled with an expanding resin generated foam substance with a compressive strength of 22 tonnes, and cannot be built upon but

are safe to remain in place for the current activities based on the technique used by RGF.

There were 7 UST on site, of which at the time of decommissioning 3 were used for Unleaded fuel and the remainder Diesel. All tanks were filled. The site was therefore removed from petrol licensing control once this was done.
