

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Am I correct that the Electricity supply for Fun Fairs in Leicester is provided and financed by Leicester City Council at no cost to the fair operators as per contract.

ANSWER

Leicester City Council can confirm that for city centre funfairs the standard procedure is to cover costs of the initial power connection. If additional services are required during the funfair due to overloading sockets etc. the funfair operator would be responsible for covering the costs of reconnection.

Funfairs operating on parks are either self-powered by generators brought in by the operator, or where a mains power connection is possible, connection and power costs are charged to the operator.
