

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

I am still interested in establishing how many extensions beyond 3m were given planning consent, therefore would it be possible to review the last 200 planning permissions to June 2013?

ANSWER

Please find attached various spread sheets which list the last 200 planning permissions to June 2013 for householder approvals that had 'EXTEN' and 'REAR' in the Proposal field. Unfortunately we were unable to filter out two storey, single storey, or dormer extensions. However, in the first column of these we have indicated if the property was a terrace (T), semi-detached (S) or detached (D). The second column indicates if the approved REAR extension went beyond 3m.

Please note that whilst the attached data shows applications that were approved where the rear extensions went beyond 3m, in such cases, there would have been mitigating circumstances which would have allowed their approval.
