

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

I am looking for some information regarding the employees you have on payroll. I would like to now:

Clarification received on: - 27.09.13

- a) **The number of current employees on payroll that are earning the national minimum wage.** Clarification – **For the first question it is the number of employees earning minimum wage, not more.**
- b) **The number of current employees on payroll that are earning less than the London living wage.** Clarification – **For the second question, I want to know how many are earning the UK living wage, which is £7.45.**

ANSWER: Figures shown are as at 1st October 2013 for all employees excluding schools.

As of 1st April 2013 Leicester City Council adopted the UK living wage of £7.45 for all employees with the exception of those on other schemes such as apprenticeships and step up scheme.

Of the 7501 employees of Leicester City Council 544 employees are paid the UK living wage of £7.45

- c) **The number of contract workers earning less than the London living wage.** Clarification – **Question C does refer to agency employees.**

There are currently 118 agency workers earning less than £7.45, this will be increased to the UK living wage once workers have been in post for 12 weeks.
