- **What hygiene rating did business achieve at the last inspection and what were the issues?**
- **What improvements are needed to achieve the top rating of '5'?**
- **When is the next inspection to see the improvements made?**
- **What are the consequences if the business did not make the necessary improvements since the last visit?**

In addition, I would like to know if you could send me the copy of the last inspection. Any information you provide on this business would be helpful and be appreciated.

ANSWER

Please find attached a copy of the last inspection report – '4036 Attachment'. Please be aware that a food hygiene rating reflects two things: the structure of a food establishment and what goes on in it.

If you take over this or any other food establishment, you will not inherit the food hygiene rating. Your business will be inspected and be given its own rating.
