

## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### **You asked:**

**Under the general requirements of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would be grateful if you would provide the following information in relation to South Knighton Area of Leicester, particularly Ratcliffe Road, Elms Road, Carisbrooke Drive and Knighton Church road.**

### **ANSWER**

I refer to your request for information under the Freedom Of Information Act 2000 in relation to Ratcliffe Rd, Elms Rd, Carisbrooke Rd & Knighton Church Rd. The information that we are supplying is detailed below and the relevant documents are attached to this letter as 3967 Attachment.

**- Dates of all safety inspections undertaken on the carriageway in the two years preceding today's date.**

Ledgers showing all inspection dates are attached.

**- Details of all carriageway defects identified during safety inspections in the two years preceding today's date.**

All works orders generated for all roads are attached.

**- Details of how carriageway safety inspections are undertaken, including whether walked or driven, the speed of the inspection vehicle and the number of persons in the vehicle.**

Walked inspection with measuring tape, intervention table, spray, camera, notepad and pen. Both sides of road are walked.

**- The intended frequency of carriageway safety inspections.**

All the named roads are inspected twice yearly.

**- Details of all complaints and/or enquiries relating to the carriageway, received in the two years preceding today's date.**
