

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

1. Has there ever been a 'give way' sign at or on the approach to the junction of Milligan Road and Grace Road. If there was, please provide records of maintenance over the past 36 months.

ANSWER

The Council holds no record of a give way sign at this location.

2. Please provide records of street lighting maintenance at the junction of Milligan Road and Grace Road.

We have no records of any faults reported at this junction. This part of Milligan Road was converted to LED lighting in July 2013.

3. Please provide details of the last time the road markings at the junction of Milligan Road and Grace were re-lined.

No lining has been carried out at the junction since 2005. That is as far back as our records go. The road markings at the junction are inspected twice a year to ensure they are visible. The last inspection was in June 2013.

4. Please inform me of whether this junction (Milligan Road/Grace Road) is due to be maintained according to your records?

Grace Road and Milligan Road are not yet programmed for highway maintenance works. Both streets are included on a list for prioritisation amongst other streets in the city. It is likely that the sites are treated under planned maintenance over the latter part of 5 years. Any emergency repairs are included as part of the safety inspection of the highway.

Milligan Road and Grace Road were last inspected in June 2013 year and both are inspected two times per year. We have no records of any safety repairs being required at the junction either on Milligan Road or Grace Road.
