

## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### **You asked:**

**Can you please provide me with most up to date details of the effective catchment areas of all the primary and secondary schools in your local authority area?**

**By catchment area, I mean the greatest distance that any pupil was living from the school they were admitted to at the point of their application. To be clear, I am only interested in the catchment area for pupils admitted on geographical criteria alone, not those admitted on other grounds eg because they had siblings at the school, was in foster care or had special needs.**

**I would prefer this information in electronic format - preferably as a machine-readable spreadsheet (.xls, .ods, etc.)**

Please find the relevant information attached. Please note that the first column labelled 'Parental Preference' refers to the furthest distance travelled by a child to attend the school requested by their parents. The 'Allocated' figure refers to the furthest distance travelled by a child who was not able to secure a place at the school preferred by their parents but was allocated a school by the local authority.

The legislation allows you to use the information supplied for your own personal use. Please be aware that any commercial or other use, for example publication, sale, or redistribution may be a breach of copyright under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended unless you obtain the copyright holder's prior permission.

Not all the information that is supplied which is covered by copyright will be the Council's copyright, for example it may be the copyright of a government department or another Council. You should seek either the Council's consent or their consent as appropriate. The Council is willing to advise you of any such potential issues on request.
