Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

1. Details of the current procurement processes for commissioning services (supported living, residential care & floating (domiciliary) support) for adults with learning disabilities and/or autism.

Leicester City Council procured its Framework Agreements for the provision of supported living services in 2012 and Framework Agreements for the provision of domiciliary care services in 2013. These Framework Agreements are for a period of two years with the option to extend for a further two years. Contracts are issued for residential care services on the basis of combined service user choice and Council decision.

2. Current tender arrangements in place and future opportunities to tender for adults with learning disabilities and/or autism.
