

## Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Housing Refurbishment Framework

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### You asked:

**“I would like to receive an up to date project directory of everyone involved in the Housing Refurbishment Framework. The Scheme comprising Rewiring and Periodic Inspection and Testing of Domestic Electrical Installations within Council Dwelling's 2013-2016. Electrical installation work. Electrical wiring and fitting work. Electrical wiring work. Electrical fitting work. Electrical supplies and accessories. Electrical services. Fire-alarm system installation work. Plastering work. City Council wishes to appoint up to 3 specialist electrical contractors to carry-out the rewiring and/or upgrading of domestic electrical systems together with associated electrical works and making good within the City Council's housing stock, city wide. In addition the contractors will be required to design, install, test and commission the systems as well as carrying out Electrical Installation Condition Reports (EICR) as necessary. The successful contractor will provide all necessary materials to complete these works. It is taking place in Leicester, Leicestershire, LE4.”**

### Answer:

We do not have a housing refurbishment framework, however, we do have a list of all contractors and suppliers involved in electrical installation, wiring and fitting work, electrical supplies and accessories, electrical services, fire-alarm system installation work and plastering work.
