**The number of Public Health Funerals have been arranged by the council in the financial years 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/2013 and the most up-to-date data you have for 2013/14. Please break this down by year, so that it is possible to see how many were arranged in each financial year.**

ANSWER:

The number of Welfare Funerals arranged by Leicester City Council are as follows:-

2010/2011	28 funerals
2011/12	45 funerals
2012/13	55 funerals
2013 14 to date	41 funerals

**2. How much money the council spent on these Public Health funerals. Please break these figures down by financial year for 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/2013 and the most up-to-date data you have for 2013/14**

Costs to Leicester City Council are as follows:-

2010/11	£8735.37
2011/12	£21234.09
2012/13	£35079.21
2013/14 to date	£5264.86
