Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### You asked:

Please could I receive a list of up to date sub contractors, suppliers and consultants who are involved in the scheme that comprises of building maintenance, responsive repairs and small works to primarily the councils non-domestic buildings. The scheme is broken down into lots: Lot 1: General building maintenance inc basic M&E services (value range £2,400,000 - £4,800,000) Lot 2: Drainage (value range £300,000 - £600,000) Lot 3: Roofing (value rang £1,600,000 - £3,200,00) Lot 4: Finishes (value range £600,000 - £1,200,000) Lot 5: Glazing and window replacement (value range £500,000 - £1,000,000) Lot 6: Electrical services (value range £4,000,000 - £8,000,000) Lot 7: Mechanical and plumbing services (value range £2,400,000 - £4,800,000) Tenders with be invited in 7 separate lots. Located at Leicester, Leicestershire, LE1.
