

## Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### You asked:

**I phoned earlier today to request the licensing restriction for all venues that are located within your councils district, in particular the restrictions on the use of glassware.**

**I was directed to the "Public Register of Premises Licences and Club Premises Certificates" documents, however it didn't contain the information I was after. I specifically need a list of venues in which licensing restrictions prevent the use of glassware in their premises, be it all the time or for specific dates or events.**

### ANSWER:

The public register contains a list of all premises licences and the conditions that apply and does contain the information requested. The information can be retrieved by viewing each record in turn. We do not have a specific list that we can supply to you, we would also need to view the Public Register to extract this information.

Then click on public register and this will take you to our search fields. Under the heading Document Type (which is located under the three icons) change the drop down to Premises. And where it says Reference Number type in LEIPRM\* (this will list all Alcohol Licence Premises) and for Clubs Premises Certificates you will need to type in LEICLB\*. And then click the middle icon (Arrow) to perform the search. This will list all the premises and you will be able to view each record in turn and find the information you are looking for.

For your information this letter constitutes a refusal notice under Section 17.1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 because an exemption under Section 21 of the Act is being applied, namely the information is accessible by other means, it's on the Council Website.

The legislation allows you to use the information supplied for your own personal use, or for journalistic purposes. If the information is a dataset (which does not relate to the environment), you may also use the information for commercial re-use under an [Open Government Licence](#).
