Clarified request received on 19/04/14

I would like a list of school projects which have provided new school places or have significantly affected the current school accommodation (refurb or remodel).

Of this list, I would like the start date of the building project and the date each building project was completed.

I would also like details of the proportion of the existing school that the major building project affected. For example, if the school was 105 places and was expanded to a two form entry school, the proportion would be 100%. If percentages prove difficult to provide, can I please have the information without this?
