

Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Under the Freedom of Information Act please give me the breakdown of the cost of providing the Music & Drama service to groups in the City and County

ANSWER:

This cost is made up as follows

Staff Time	£18,000
Transport fees for sets of music to be delivered between library services	£2,000
New Stock	£3,000
Income from subscriptions	- £5,000
Net Cost	£18,000

The consultation ends on 18 May and no decisions will be made until the council's Executive has had a chance to consider feedback from the consultation.
