

Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

How many cases of ASB (Antisocial Behaviour) were reported in the time from 1.1.2013 till 31.12.2013 to LCC and how many cases of ASB were concluded from LASBU (Leicester Anti Social Behaviour Unit) during that time and which kind of Antisocial Behaviour was reported and resolved.

Clarification received on 16/04/14:-

The request is for Antisocial behaviour which is concern of the LASBU - Department and which of reports have been investigated from LASBU and from then concluded.

ANSWER:

From 01.01.2013 to 31.12.2013 there have been 1184 cases of Antisocial behaviour which have been opened and closed where LASBU has had involvement.
