Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Under the F.O.I Act, please can you supply the following information please.

- 1) A list detailing the location of bus lanes in Leicester;**
- 2) A list detailing the location of bus gates in Leicester;**
- 3) A list detailing the bus lanes in Leicester that have a bus lane enforcement camera in Leicester (the exact location of each camera is not required - instead, I am looking only for whether the road has a bus lane enforcement camera);**
- 4) A list detailing the bus gates in Leicester that have a bus gate enforcement camera in Leicester (the exact location of each camera is not required - instead, I am looking only for whether the road has a bus gate enforcement camera).**

By 'Leicester', I am referring to the City of Leicester in addition to any roads on the approaching Leicester for which you have information.
