

Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Please could you give me a list of schools in your area that have installed PV solar panels, their addresses (including postcodes) and how much capacity has been installed on each one?

If possible, please could you include the school's email address too.

ANSWER:

PV installations on schools are generally a school's responsibility; therefore we do not have the full details for each school. Please find attached the information that we do hold, the primary schools information is not complete, however the information for secondary schools is more complete. This is because the secondary schools have been rebuilt as part of the Building Schools for the Future programme. Please find attached spreadsheet with a list of the schools and how much capacity has been installed on each one.
