

## Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### You asked:

I had requested that you compare the number of contraventions in the bus lane that I travelled in on this day during the road works to the number of contraventions at the same time and same day when the road works were not present? If you take an average over the last 6 months I am certain you will find that the number of contraventions on this day are substantially higher than the average as I suspect that there were several other unsuspecting drivers who have also been unfairly penalised due to the poorly managed road works fiasco. Could you please provide me with the analysis of this exercise?

ANSWER: Contravention Date Sunday 18/05/2014 at 11:05, Charles Street

Please see table below with the requested information. We have taken every Sunday from 01/01/2014 to Sunday 22/06/2014 timed between 10:45 to 11:15.

Please note that on 18th May 2014 we issued 3 tickets altogether which however does not necessarily mean that they came through the road works as they could have come from another direction onto Charles Street.
