Please find attached a list of Development Groups in Leicester.

Federations – there are three Federations in Leicester – 1) Sparkenhoe / Medway Primary Federation. 2) Madani Boys / Girls Schools Federation (Secondary). 3) Keyham / Millgate federation (Special).

Teaching School Alliances – There is one in the City – Rushey Mead Teaching School Alliance known as Leicester Teaching School (LeTS). Strategic Partner schools are the core of the Teaching School Alliance, both contributing to and using alliance services. Their membership of Challenge Partners means that LeTS is collectively accountable for these schools in terms of continuing improvement in attainment, teaching and learning and Ofsted categories.
