

Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

I would like to see details of land and property owned by your local authority which is vacant or not currently in use by the local authority - split by the number of sites and the cumulative land area the sites cover. I would be obliged if you could provide the data in a spreadsheet format with four columns providing the following information:

- a) Number of local authority land and/or property sites that are vacant and/or not in use by the local authority;
- b) Area of (a) in sq km;
- c) A subset of (a) showing the number of land and/or property sites not in use by the local authority, but being utilised by another organisation;
- d) Area of (c) in sq km.

ANSWER: Please see table below with the above information.
