Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below. Some information in the attached documents has been redacted under the Data Protection Act 1998 which is exempt under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Section 40, Personal Information.

You asked:

- 1. All Opening/Closing notices for any works carried out in the footway at the above location for 2 years prior and up to the date of the incident.**

- 3. Records of complaints about the state of the relevant stretch of footway for 2 years prior to the incident date.**

Our records show that there have been no complaints and enquiries received about the relevant section of footway on Tudor Road during the two years before the incident date.

- 4. Records of other accidents that have occurred on the relevant stretch of footway.**

We are not aware of any accidents occurring on the relevant section of footway in the 2 years prior to the incident date.

- 5. Maintenance records including records of independent contractors working in the relevant stretch of footway for 2 years prior and up to the date of the incident.**

The highway maintenance records for the section of footway are shown at item 2. They do not include records of contractors working at the location.


