Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

- 1. Do you offer HR support to schools and/or academies, on a traded basis?**

If so, please provide the following information for the 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12 financial years:

- (a) The number of schools and/or academies that purchased your HR service in**

We operate different levels of service and the charges are also based on the number of employees at each establishment. Although all 108 schools buy into our service the level of service offered has changed year on year.

- (b) The annual charge(s) for your traded HR service**

The charges are as follows:

2009/10 from £1,261 to £11,432

2010/11 from £1,261 to £11,432

2011/12 from £1,652 to £12,855

- (c) The revenue generated from your traded HR service**

2009-10 £545,384

2010-11 £565,492

We are not able to provide figures for the current financial year.

- (d) The number of FTE staff employed as part of your traded HR service**

10.36 FTE in each of the three years in question.
