Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked

Can you please provide details of all contracts you have with G4S Plc, specifically what service it is they provide, the length of that contract and how much money the contract is worth per annum. Please also provide the same details of any contract they are currently tendering for with your authority.

Response

We do not currently have any contracts with G4S as the contract they did have for the provision of cash in transit services expired in May and we are utilising an ESPO framework for these services. We have no record of any live tenders which G4S are currently bidding for."

The Authority has entered into a long term strategic partnering relationship agreement with Leicester Miller Education Company Limited (LEP) relating, inter alia, to the delivery of improved education facilities and services, to which G4S are one of LEP's, supply chain Contractors as well as shareholders within the LEP.


