

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - PCN

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

On attending Welford Road on Saturday evening 19th Nov 2011 I initially drove over the railway bridge on the Welford Road at approx 17:10 and while driving past noticed that three cars had parked on the grass verge next to this said bridge.

On parking my car I walked down Lancaster Road towards the ground and along Tigers Way. There were two attendants present at the time, and at the time there were no cars parked on the grass verges. On leaving the ground at approx 20:10 however, there was a rather large 4x4 vehicle parked under the trees, on the grass verge on Tigers Way.

1. Therefore can I request a FOIA report on whether any of these vehicles were issued with a PCN on this said night.

I can confirm that no PCNs were issued to any vehicles on Welford Road or Tigers Way on 19/11/11.
