

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - Buxton St/Melbourne St

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Incident Location: Junction of Buxton Street / Melbourne Street
(After clarification sought: **Please accept this as confirmation for the location that we are request LA records for Junction of Buxton Street / Melbourne Road Leicester LE2 0FH**)

Incident Date: 28/07/2011

Virgin Media are currently dealing with a personal injury claim that occurred at the above location.

- All Opening/Closing notices for any works carried out in the footway/carriageway at the above location for 2 years prior and up to the date of the incident.**

On checking our records there were no works carried out within the time period requested therefore there are no such notices registered under Melbourne Road jnc Buxton Street.

- Records of inspection for the relevant stretch of highway/carriageway including details of any defects found for 2 years prior and up to the date of the incident.**

We have searched the highway inspection registers showing details of routine safety inspections of Melbourne Road and Buxton Street. None of the works orders raised following the inspections are for the relevant section of footway.

- Records of complaints about the state of the relevant stretch of highway/carriageway for 2 years prior to the incident date.**

Please find attached customer request id number 64519 and associated reply. This is the only complaint covering the relevant section of footway.

- Records of other accidents that have occurred on the relevant stretch of highway/carriageway.**

Please find attached customer request id number 66850 in relation to an accident on Buxton Street and request id number 76764 in relation to an accident on Buxton Street junction with Melbourne Road.

- Maintenance records including records of independent contractors working in the relevant stretch of highway/carriageway for 2 years prior and up to the date of the incident.**

No highway repairs were carried out on this stretch of footway in the two years prior to the accident.


