You asked: For information regarding 24 Finch Close, Leicester.

- 1. I require copies of the highway inspection records together with all opening/closing notices, defect notices and records of complaints for 2 years prior to 29 April 2011.**

The Highway inspection register shows details of routine safety inspections. The copies of work orders include 10113732 and 09103732, which were issued following routine safety inspections. For additional information work order 09103732 was outside 24 Finch Close and a photograph of the defect that was repaired is enclosed with documents.

The only other repair order issued during the two year period was outside number 17 which was as a result of a customer contact reference number 66061, copy of customer contact form with the documents. There were no complaints received about this location.


