Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

The local authority's gross budget for the years 2006-2011. If you have details of this for 2012, I would appreciate that too.

The local authority's net budget for the years 2006-2011. If you have details of this for 2012, I would appreciate that too.

The table below sets out the gross and net budgets for the years 2006/07 to 2011/12 as approved by Council. The budget for 2012/13 is due to be considered by Council on 22nd February 2012 and therefore is draft only at this stage.

* nb this is a presentational change due to the requirements of the Localism Act 2011. A comparative figure prepared under the previous legislation (Local Govt Finance Act 1992) would be £275,259,000


