

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 I wish to officially request the following information for the Leicester City Centre parking zone:

1. Meter Bays- number of bays, tariffs, max stay, grid references

ANSWER

There are 188 bays in the City Centre Parking Zone. For existing on-street charges please see attachment 1. Max stay varies between 2hrs, 3hrs and 12 hrs. Leicester City Council does not hold Information about grid references.

2. Car Parks, Council & Private - opening hours, type, nos of bays, tariffs, park mark grid references

5. Electric car charge points - grid references


