Number of unique visitors to www.leicester.gov.uk last calendar year were: 1,679,926. Please note this figure is as far as it is possible to tell if people are unique visitors.

Number of page views per year (last calendar year or rolling year)

Number of page views to www.leicester.gov.uk last calendar year were: 11,695,230.


