

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Can you please send me all tenders currently in process for the following areas explaining the full requirements to ascertain if my company can undergo and successfully achieve the acquisition of these contracts?

ANSWER:

There are no current tenders for these services. It has come to light that the end dates for these contracts on the Contracts Database did not take account of permitted extensions. The current position with each contract is set out below.

Reference no 1518 : Case Management Systems: Current suppliers Northgate arinsoi UK Ltd / Ending 31/12/2012

Contract end date is August 2014 and as such there are no current tenders for these services. The future procurement process will depend upon the business needs of the Council in 2013. The Council does not hold this information. Therefore this letter acts as a refusal notice under section 17.1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 because, in accordance with section 1.1 of the Act, this information is not held by Leicester City Council.

1813: Resource and financial Management : Current Suppliers Aggressi Limited / Ending 7/5/2012

The Agresso contract has been renewed for a further five years. The future procurement process will depend upon the business needs of the Council in 2016 and as such there are no current tenders for these services. The Council does not hold this information. 
