

## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

### **You asked:**

**I would like to know details of contracts held by the authority with external organisations for the treatment of waste collected by the authority (or its collection contractor).**

### **ANSWER**

Leicester City Council has an all inclusive PFI contract with Biffa Waste Services for the collection, treatment and disposal of household and municipal waste from May 2003 to May 2028. Included in that contract is the management of the 2 household waste recycling centres within the city.

Dry recyclables are collected kerbside and the residual waste is treated mechanically to separate out the organic waste, which is then anaerobically treated. The responsibility for the disposal of all recyclates, green waste, organic residues and landfill is with Biffa.


