I can confirm that Leicester City Council holds this information. The information is exempt under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), because the information is accessible to you, as it is already in the public domain.

We are not able to provide the names of individual employees that are not published on our webpage as this is considered to be an absolute exemption under section 40(2) (personal data), and this part of the letter constitutes a refusal under section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Council does not classify any of its Managers as 'procurement Managers' so we would need more information on the type of posts you are referring to. It may be that when you look at the Council website, as detailed above, your question is answered there. If not, please provide further details about the type of post you are looking for so that we can identify the information you are requesting. Once you have clarified your request, we will be able to reconsider it. Under section 1(3) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), a public authority need not comply with a request unless any further information reasonably required to locate the information is supplied.

The legislation allows you to use the information supplied for your own personal use. Please be aware that any commercial or other use, for example publication, sale, or redistribution may be a breach of copyright under the

Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended unless you obtain the copyright holder's prior permission.

Not all the information that is supplied which is covered by copyright will be the Council's copyright, for example it may be the copyright of a government department or another Council. You should seek either the Council's consent or their consent as appropriate. The Council is willing to advise you of any such potential issues on request. 
