The table shows that 15 firms supplied PQQs. 8 passed and 7 failed. Of the 8 who passed we only have tender scores for 5 of them. Of these 5 the scores were as per above. The contract was awarded to JCL Services.

To the extent that we do not hold scores for all companies, this is therefore a refusal notice under section 17.1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 because, in accordance with section 1.1 of the Act, this information is not held by Leicester City Council.


