

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Your request for information has now been considered and the Council's response to your questions is shown below.

You asked:

Can you please send me information on the cost, length, planning status, funding status and proposed construction date of the following schemes:

Eastern District Distributor Road. This would complete the link between the A6 and A46

ANSWER

Cost – no information available

Length – no information available

Planning status – no planning permission (but there is a highway improvement scheme declared on searches and there are highway improvement lines declared on searches)

Funding status – no funding allocated

Proposed construction date – no dates set

A Southern Relief Road linking from the A6 South 'London Road' (corridor) to the M1 Junction 21 Fosse Park area.

There is no information available on the questions asked as the scheme has no status and no planning permission as far as the City Council is aware.

An Eastern Bypass scheme that could provide a parallel route for traffic from the east to the south that currently uses the A46/M1

There is no information available on the questions asked as the scheme has no status and no planning permission as far as the City Council is aware.
