PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2014

Notice is hereby given that Leicester City Council ('the Council') has made the following Order under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ('the Act') as follows.

This Order may be cited as the Public Spaces Protection Order (Leicester City) 2014 and comes into force on 5 January 2015. This Order will have effect for a period of 3 years, until 31 December 2017.

The effect of this Order is to prohibit consumption of alcohol within an area and to require specified things to be done by person/s consuming alcohol in that area. The 'area' referred to is that as set out in the plans attached to this Order at Schedule 1.

- 1. This Order applies to all persons within the area, whether resident or otherwise, at all times of the day and night and in circumstances where a Police Officer, Community Support Officer or other Authorised Person reasonably believes that the consumption of alcohol has or is likely to have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality.
- 2. Pursuant to section 63 of the Act, where a Police Officer, Community Support Officer or other Authorised Person requires that a person desists from consuming alcohol (or the item reasonably believed to be alcohol), or surrender the alcohol (or item which is reasonably believed to be alcohol) and the person fails to do so, that person shall be committing an offence as set out below.
- 3. A person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a requirement imposed on him or her by a Police Officer, Community Support Officer or other Authorised Person as set out at point 2 above, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £500;
- 4. A Police Officer, Community Support Officer or other Authorised Person may dispose of anything surrendered pursuant to this Order, as they see fit.
