RE: Pop-Up Cycle Lane - Aylestone Road

Leicester City Council has been awarded funds from Active Travel England to support the development of 'key worker corridors' to provide attractive choices for people to access work, education, local and other facilities.

Proposed Scheme

The temporary pop-up cycle lanes introduced during the 'Covid-19 Lockdown' along Aylestone Road will be made permanent. The scheme consisting of uni-directional cycle tracks commences just prior to the junction with Richmond Avenue and finishes just beyond the Euro Garages County Service Station. The scheme will consist of more durable kerbs and wands with vertical features. A copy of the design is attached.

City Highways on behalf of Leicester City Council will be carrying out the proposed works. The work will be undertaken in 8 phases, commencing on Monday 18 $^{\rm h}$ September and scheduled for completion on Friday 24 $^{\rm h}$ November. A full road closure will be implemented on September 24 $^{\rm th}$ and Sunday 8 $^{\rm th}$ October only. All other works will be carried out under a traffic light system operating 24 x 7 for the duration of the scheme. Work will be undertaken between 7.30am - 3.30pm.
