Code of Practice for Gypsies & Travellers

For occupants of unauthorised
encampments in Leicester,
Leicestershire and Rutland

10/20



The Code of Practice applies to all land in Local Authority ownership or control, including highway land.

Any stay on land is limited in time and is dependent on the occupants complying with the Code.

Failure to comply is likely to result in action to move on the occupants being taken either by the Local Authority concerned or the Police.

Whilst you are on this location, please:

- Keep groups small
- Drive and park vehicles safely, avoid creating a hazard
- Look after the land that you park on and do not cause problems for neighbours
- Avoid burning rubbish that causes a nuisance to others
- Keep animals under control
- Keep land clean and tidy, use the refuse bags provided for household waste.
- Avoid blocking Rights of Way with vehicles or property.
- Do not engage in acts of vandalism or criminal activity.
- Do not intimidate Local Authority officers, other agencies or members of the public

Moving On

Once any agreed period of occupation has run out, the site must be vacated and not be re-occupied within a three month period.

The condition in which you leave the site will be taken into account when you wish to camp on a new site
